

WILSON PARKING AUSTRALIA "COYOTE VS ACME" WARNER BROS. MOVIE WORLD
FAMILY ADVENTURE COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The following terms and conditions apply for the Wilson Parking Australia "COYOTE VS ACME" Warner Bros. Movie World Family Adventure Competition (the "Competition") and by submitting an entry into this Competition, entrants warrant that they have read, understand and agree to be bound by them.

1.2 These terms and conditions can be downloaded from www.wilsonparking.com.au ("the website").

2. PROMOTER

The promoter is Wilson Parking Australia 1992 Pty Ltd (ABN 67 052 475 911) (the "Promoter"), Floor 2, 7 Macquarie Place SYDNEY NSW 2000.

3. DURATION

Entries will be taken from 6.00am (AEST) Wednesday 26 August, 2025 until 9.00pm (AEST) on Sunday 20 September, 2026 inclusive ("Registration Period").

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Entry is available to permanent residents of NSW/VIC/QLD/SA/WA/ACT.

4.2 Employees and the immediate families of the Promoter and its related bodies corporate are ineligible to enter. Employees and the immediate families of all associated sponsors and participating companies are also ineligible to enter.

4.3 A completed Spott parking transaction is only eligible if it is not cancelled, amended or refunded in any other way.

4.4 Only one entry per Spott parking transaction will be counted as an eligible entry.

5. METHOD OF ENTRY

5.1 To enter, entrants must make a valid Spott parking transaction at any Spott enabled Wilson Parking location between 6.00am (AEST) Wednesday 26 August, 2026 and 9.00pm (AEST) on Sunday 20 September, 2026 inclusive. Entrants must then fill out the entry form at <https://info.wilsonparking.com.au/spott-your-way-to-movie-world> and include their name, a valid email address and contact phone number, and answer in 50 words or less, "How Spott helps you stay one step ahead when you're on the go". Entries will be collected through HubSpot CRM. The most creative answer will win the major prize, followed by 10 runners up that will win a runners up prize.

5.2 Entrants must park with Spott, therefore have a completed Spott parking transaction between 6.00am (AEST) Wednesday 26 August, 2026 and 9.00pm (AEST) on Sunday 20 September, 2026 in order to be eligible to complete the entry form and enter the competition.

5.3 Entries not containing a valid email address or contact number will be ineligible to enter. Only one entry per email address will be accepted.

5.4 Should an entrant's contact details change during the promotional period, it is the entrant's responsibility to notify the Promoter. A request to access or modify any information provided in an entry should be directed to the Promoter.

6. DRAWING

6.1 One (1) valid entry will be selected as the most creative by our judges at the conclusion of the promotion as the major prize winner. Ten (10) entries will also be selected as runners up. Decisions will be made at or before 5pm on Monday 21 September, 2026 at the offices of Wilson Parking, Floor 2, 7 Macquarie Place SYDNEY NSW 2000. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

7. PRIZE(s)

7.1 All prize values are the recommended retail value as provided by the supplier, are in Australian Dollars. Total prize value for the major prize is up to \$6,976. The total prize value for runners up prizes is \$3,500.

7.2 There is one (1) major prize to be won, comprising of:

- One (1) x Family pass/day entry (inclusive of two (2) adults and two (2) children (under the age of 16 years)) to Warner Bros. Movie World, Pacific Hwy, Oxenford QLD 4210 (Theme Park), valued at AUD \$476 (incl. GST).

The Prize is valued at up to AUD \$476 (incl. GST).

Domestic Travel Prize

If a Prize winner ordinarily resides in NSW, VIC, SA, WA or ACT, the winner will be awarded a Domestic Travel Prize, provided that their state's border restrictions permit travel into QLD. For the avoidance of doubt, the Domestic Travel Prize will not be awarded if the winner's ordinary state of residence is QLD.

The Domestic Travel Prize will comprise of:

- Four (4) x return economy flights, for the winner and three (3) companions from the winner's nearest capitol city in the state they ordinarily reside to Gold Coast, Queensland (inclusive of airfare related taxes and charges), including airport transfers for winner and three (3) companion/s from the destination-airport to Accommodation, valued at up to AUD \$4,424 (incl. GST) (Airlines).
- Four (4) x nights in a family share room (two (2) adults and two (2) children) at a minimum 3.5 star accommodation in Gold Coast, QLD, to be determined and specified by the Prize supplier, to be shared by the winner and three (3) companions, inclusive of breakfast, valued at up to \$1,600 (incl. GST) (Accommodation).

The Domestic Travel Prize is valued at up to AUD \$6,500 (incl. GST).

7.3 There are ten (10) runners up prizes to be won.

Each prize pack includes:

- 2 x Double film passes = \$108 (while film is in season at any participating cinema in Australia)
- 2 x Tshirts = \$100
- 2 x Caps = \$100
- 4 x Badges = \$42

8. PRIZE CONDITIONS

8.1 The Promoter does not warrant the merchantability, suitability and/or fitness for purpose of any goods and/or services awarded as a prize.

8.2 No other costs will be included other than those specifically referred to above, anything else will be at the winner's cost.

8.3 All prizes are subject to availability, non-transferable and non-exchangeable, must be used on any dates specified in these terms and conditions, by the Promoter and/or the prize provider and are not redeemable for cash unless cash is specified. Specifically, prizes may not be valid during school holidays or other peak times designated by the prize supplier.

8.4 If a prize winner does not take any element of a prize at the time stipulated by the Promoter then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that prize or any part of it.

8.5 It will be each winner's responsibility to take out all relevant insurance (including but not limited to travel insurance) which may be required or prudent to be taken (at their own cost).

Prize terms and conditions include:

- Prize has no cash alternative, is non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Blackout periods apply, prize not available during Australian Public or National holiday periods.
- Travel dates must be confirmed within 45 days of notification.
- One winner must be over 18 years of age.
- All elements are subject to availability at time of booking.
- Accommodation is based on a family share room.
- A valid credit card must be presented at hotel check in for incidentals. Tickets are non-transferable (i.e. no name changes allowed). Once tickets are issued, they are non-endorsable and non-transferable. Any alterations to confirmed flights and/or accommodation details will be at the expense of the winner. All components of the Prize must be fulfilled at the same time and they cannot be split across different time periods. Any changes by the winner made to the specified prize package (including travel extensions, additional guests, etc) will be subject to an administration fee of \$250 excluding GST, which must be settled in full prior to booking confirmation.
- Individual supplier terms and conditions apply. Once the Prize has been arranged, any changes to the travel, flights, accommodation or scheduling arrangements are at the expense of the Winner and their travelling companions.
- Flights: Flights are economy class and may be indirect. The airline's Conditions of Carriage apply to all flights. The Winner and travelling companions must travel at the same time and are responsible for transport from their residence to their nearest Capital City Airport in Australia. The winner and their travelling companions will responsible for making their way to and from their departing Australian airport.
- Airline, flight route and dates of travel are subject to the promoter's absolute and final decision.
- Winners and guest travel at their own risk and, if for any reason any aspect of this promotion is not capable of running as planned, including war, terrorism, state of emergency, pandemic, or any other kind of disaster, tampering or computer virus, the Promoter reserves the right to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the promotion or suspend, substitute or modify a prize, subject to any written directions from a relevant regulatory authority.
- Winner must obtain their own travel insurance and proof of insurance be provided before tickets are issued.
- Winners must follow any Covid-19 conditions and restrictions which may apply, but not limited to, travel, hotel and events.

9. NOTIFICATION

Prize winner will be notified on Tuesday 22 September 2026 by email and/or phone.

Winners name will be published in a news story on www.wilsonparking.com.au website

If the winner does not respond to contact made by 5pm Monday 28 September 2026, the prize will be forfeited to the next available winner. No replacement prize will be given.

10. PRIZE COLLECTION

10.1 The Promoter reserves the right to request winners to provide proof of identity, proof of residency and/or proof of entry validity in order to claim a prize. Proof of identity, residency and/or entry validity considered suitable for verification is at the Promoter's discretion. In the event that a winner cannot provide suitable proof, the winner will forfeit the prize in whole and no substitute will be offered.

10.2 All prize winners must sign these terms and conditions in a form prescribed by the Promoter in order to receive their prize.

11. PRIZE AVAILABILITY

11.1 The Promoter will not be responsible or liable if for any reason beyond their reasonable control any element of any prize is not provided. The Promoter may, subject to State regulations, substitute a different prize of equivalent value in place of any prize referred to in these terms and conditions.

11.2 The Promoter will not be responsible for any changes in times or dates, or cancellations or rescheduling of events that may prevent the prize winner from redeeming the prize or any part of it.

12. TAXES

Any tax payable as a result of a prize being awarded or received will be the responsibility of the winner. Winners should seek independent financial advice prior to accepting a prize if this is a concern.

13. PUBLICITY MATERIALS

It is a condition of entry that the Promoter has the right to publicise the names, characters, likenesses or voices of any entrants for any promotion or matter incidental to the Competition.

14. RELEASE AND INDEMNITY

To the extent permitted by law, all entrants release from, and indemnify the Promoter against all liability, cost, loss or expense arising out of acceptance of any prize(s) or participation in the Competition including (but not limited to) loss of income, loss of opportunity, personal injury and damage to property, whether direct or consequential, foreseeable, due to some negligent act or omission or otherwise.

15. TAMPERING AND OTHER MATTERS

15.1 If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned as a result of any (including but not limited to) technical failures, unauthorised intervention, computer virus, mobile phone failure, tampering, fraud or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition, the Promoter reserves the right (subject to State regulations) to disqualify any individual who (whether directly or indirectly) causes the same and/or to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition.

15.2 The Promoter accepts no responsibility for any late, lost or misdirected entries including but not limited to electronic messages not received by the Promoter due to technical disruptions, network congestion or any other reason.

15.3 The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that permits any person to enter the Competition repeatedly is prohibited.

16. EMAIL BOUNCE BACK AND INABILITY TO CONTACT

16.1 If an email message sent by the Promoter related to participation or entry in the Competition, bounces back, or cannot be delivered, or the entrant cannot be contacted by phone, the Promoter may contact another entrant via email or phone. In such event, the Promoter will not be responsible for the awarding of any prize to the email recipient whose email was not received.

16.2 If a contestant or winner is not successfully contacted via email due to bounce back or undeliverable from the Promoter related to participation or entry in the Competition that person will be disqualified and a replacement contestant or winner (whichever is applicable) will be selected by the Promoter.

17. MINORS

17.1 If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years these terms and conditions must be signed by the prize winner's parent or legal guardian before the prize is awarded and the prize may at the absolute discretion of the Promoter be awarded to the prize winner's parent or legal guardian.

18. TERMINATION OF COMPETITION

The Promoter may (subject to State Regulations), vary the terms of or terminate this Competition at any time at its absolute discretion without liability to any contestant or other person. The Promoter will not award the prize if the Competition is terminated.

19. DECISIONS FINAL

All decisions and actions of the Promoter relating to the Competition and/or redemption of the prizes are exercised according its absolute discretion and are final. No discussions or correspondence with entrants or any other person will be entered into.

20. FAILURE TO ENFORCE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A failure by the Promoter to enforce any one of these terms and conditions in any instance(s) will not give rise to any claim or right of action by any other person or contestant.

21. PERSONAL INFORMATION AND PRIVACY

The personal information supplied by entrants when entering this Competition will be used by the Promoter in accordance with its Privacy Policy. Please refer to the Privacy Policy by visiting the website for more information as entry in this Competition is an agreement to be bound by that policy. The contact details of the winner only will be given to Pinnacle Films in order to fulfil the prize requirements.
